Re: Pupil Premium Funding

Dear Parents

Are you entitled to additional funding for your child? Did you know that the school may be able to access an extra pot of money to support your child through their education? This funding is called "Pupil Premium" and if your child needs it, it can be used:

- to provide extra classroom support and resources
- to fund extra-curricular school clubs
- to provide financial support towards class trips
- to provide free school meals for as long as they are entitled to the Pupil Premium.

Your child is entitled to this if you as a parent / carer claim any of the following:

- Income Support
- Income-based Job Seekers Allowance
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- Support under part VI of the Immigration and Asylum act 1999
- The Guarantee element of State Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit, provided you are not entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual income (as assessed by HM Revenue and Customs) that does not exceed £16,190
- You will not normally be eligible if you are receiving any amount of Working Tax Credit

A Pupil Premium eligibility form is attached to this letter. If you have any questions regarding the Pupil Premium or would like help completing the form, please do not hesitate to contact Mrs Lloyd in the school office. Any information provided will be treated with the utmost confidentiality and will only be passed onto Wakefield Local Authority for further assessment as to your entitlement.
